- **REVIEW YOUR FAFSA SUBMISSION SUMMARY**, which will be sent via email from Federal Student Aid.
- **CREATE YOUR STUDENT ACCOUNT** at the college by following instructions from the admissions office.
- **RESPOND TO VERIFICATION REQUESTS** from the college financial aid office in a timely manner so your aid can be processed guickly.
- **REVIEW YOUR FINANCIAL AID OFFER** and accept only what you will need to complete the 2025-26 academic year.
- **COMPLETE ENTRANCE COUNSELING** if you accept student loans, to understand your rights and responsibilities as a Borrower.
- SIGN YOUR MASTER PROMISSORY NOTE if you accept student loans. PROMISING TO REPAY any money that you borrow.
- **FINANCIAL AID WILL BE** sent directly to your college and **DEPOSITED INTO YOUR STUDENT ACCOUNT.**
