Who is Lela?



The Louisiana Education Loan Authority (Lela) is Louisiana's nonprofit resource for free FAFSA completion assistance, college access and affordable financing, and is a division of the Louisiana Public Facilities Authority (LPFA)—a nonprofit public trust established to bring financing assistance and advantages to the people of Louisiana. Lela's mission is to develop projects and programs which provide resources for college access and statewide outreach initiatives to help ensure students' success on their path to and through college. The Lela team assists families remotely with FAFSA completion through its free virtual completion sessions, its FAFSA HELpline, and now in-person sessions at Lela's Student Success Center in Baton Rouge. Lela also offers free resources to Louisiana high school counselors and provides low cost supplemental loans for college expenses. (see back cover)

college Financial Aid **PROCESS**

— 2026 - 2027 —

- **COMPLETE COLLEGE ADMISSIONS** applications and meet all requirements.
- **CREATE AN FSA ID** for the student and parent at studentaid.gov/fsa-id/create-account.
- **COMPLETE THE 2027-28 FAFSA** on or after October 1, 2026 using 2025 IRS tax return.
- **REVIEW YOUR FAFSA SUBMISSION SUMMARY** for accuracy, which will be sent to the student's email from Federal Student Aid.
- After college acceptance, **CREATE A STUDENT ACCOUNT** as instructed by the admissions office.
- **RESPOND TO VERIFICATION REQUESTS** from your college financial aid office so your aid can be processed quickly.
- **DOWNLOAD THE "AWARD ADVISOR" APP** to compare your financial aid offers.
- **REVIEW YOUR FINANCIAL AID OFFER** and accept only what you will need to complete the 2027-28 academic year.
- **COMPLETE ENTRANCE COUNSELING** if you accept student loans to understand your rights & responsibilities as a borrower and sign your master promissory note, **PROMISING TO REPAY** what you've borrowed.
- **FINANCIAL AID** will be sent directly to your college for deposit into your student account. Any excess funds will be available for withdrawal after all college expenses have been covered.
